### FEATURED OPPORTUNITY: OXFORD PROGRAM

The Oxford Summer Study Abroad Program is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for Georgia Tech Honors Program students to earn credit while experiencing Europe and the UK. Every summer, a group of HP students travel through Europe for five weeks, followed by an additional six weeks in residence at Mansfield College in Oxford. Students take HP classes, such as HTS 3032: European Intellectual History, HTS 3033: History of Medieval England, and MGT 4803: International Business Ethics, while earning up to six credit hours that apply towards their HP curriculum requirement.

In addition to academic rigor, HP students also participate in enrichment activities, including an HP walking tour of Oxford and creating a blog to share their experiences. Students have praised the program, noting that the chance to travel, learn about different cultures, and form new friendships has been one of the best experiences of their lives.
