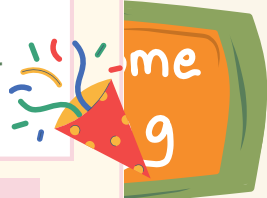

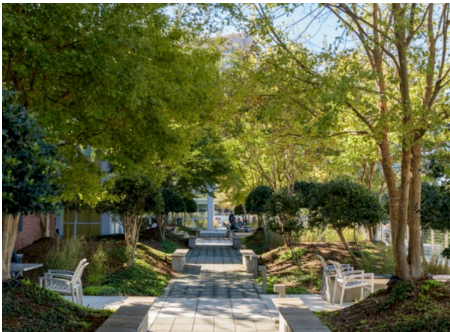

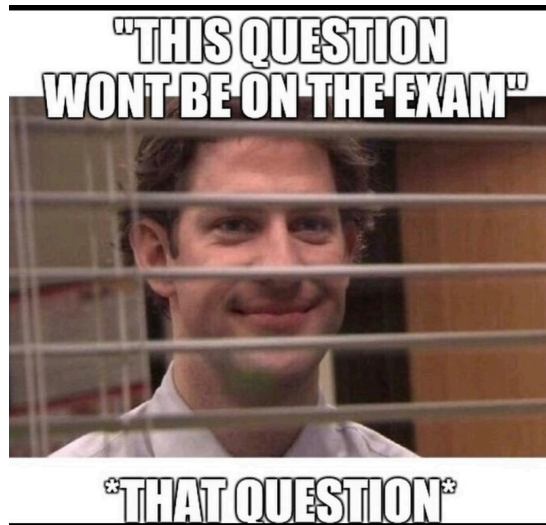

SAMADHI'S EASY COLLEGE RECIPES

Strawberry Sparkler Mocktails

Most people that know this series know that I love to talk about easy, healthy meals for college students to prep for the week. But, I recently have become a big advocate for balance and enjoying fun things in life. This easy, refreshing Strawberry Sparkler is a perfect spring mocktail for all ages to celebrate the fresh colors emerging!

Key Ingredients:

- Strawberries: Fresh, hulled, and sliced (approx. 4-5).
- Lemon Juice: Freshly squeezed.
- Sweetener: Honey, maple syrup, or simple syrup.
- Sparkler: Sparkling water, club soda, or lemon-lime soda.
- Optional: Fresh mint leaves or basil.

Preparation:

- Muddle: In a glass, combine strawberries, honey/syrup, and lemon juice. Muddle well until the berries are broken down.
- Ice: Fill the glass with ice cubes.
- Sparkle: Top with sparkling water (my personal preference is Sprite).
- Stir & Garnish: Stir gently and garnish with a strawberry slice, lemon wheel, or mint.

Extra:

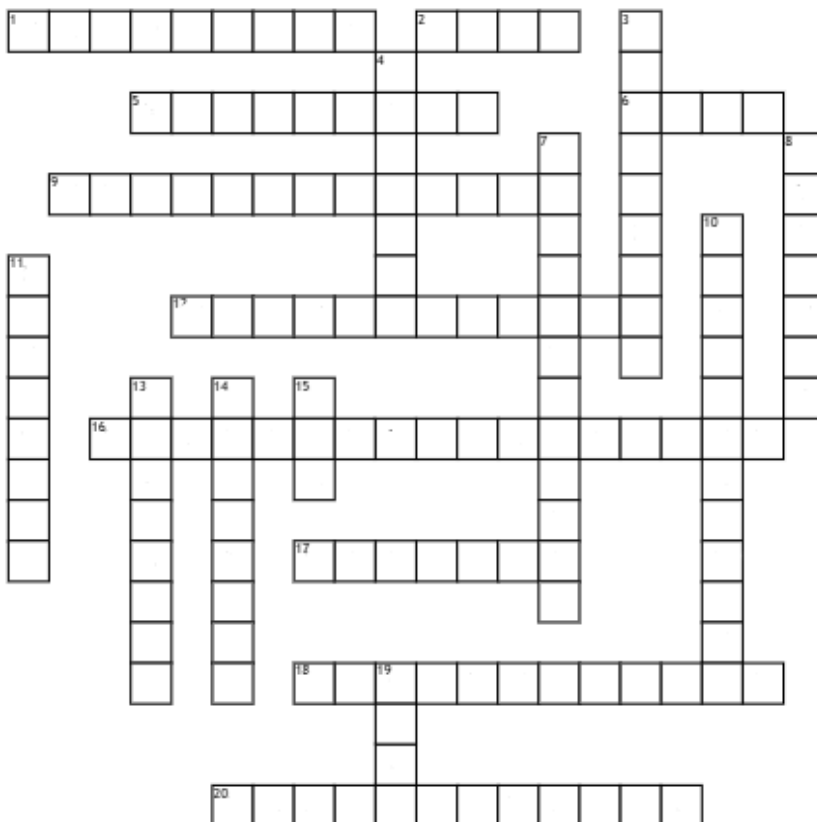
- Berry Ice Cubes: Freeze blueberries or small strawberry pieces into your ice cubes.
- Rim the Glass: Dip the rim of your glass in honey and then into red sugar crystals (I like to crush up red JollyRanchers).
- Garnish: Use a skewer with fresh strawberries for a fancy look.
- Edible Glitter: my best friend introduced me to this idea and it's one of my favorites!

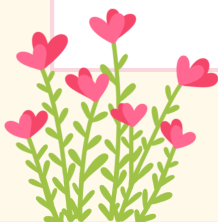

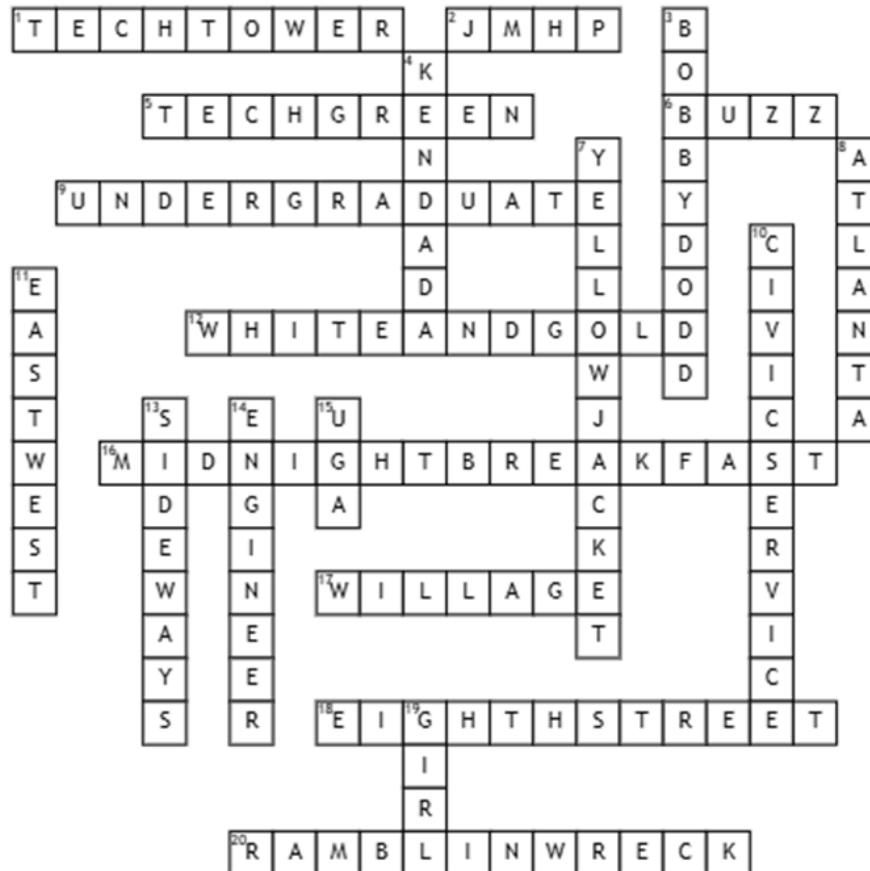
